





Important Note:

- Students who do NOT attain the minimum required attendance as per University guidelines will NOT be allowed to appear in the Sessional/Annual Examination.
- It is Mandatory for all students to appear in Sessional Exam. Average of the marks shall be taken for computation purpose.
- Students who wish to appear in the Improvement Exam need to apply for the same for individual subjects. The fee for the improvement exam is Rs. 2000/- per subject.
- The Improvement Exam shall act as a "Substitute" for any one of the sessional exam for that particular subject.
- For a student, who has appeared in the sessional exam and also in the Improvement Exam for a particular subject, the average of two best scores would be considered.
- Sessional Exam copies to shown to students within one week of completion of exam.
- Students are advised to deposit their fee at the earliest to avoid long queues on late days.
- Admit card for appearing in end sem. Exam would only be given to students after deposition of second installment of fee.


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
