## PROGRAMMES OFFERED

The Department of Languages caters to the needs of the students aspiring for training, expertise and excellence in Professional Communication with a marked emphasis on English for Specific / Special Purposes (ESP). The Department offers courses on the English Language, Grammar and Soft Skills (EL), Professional Communication (PC), Professional Communication Lab to BCA, BBA, MBA, B. Com., B. Tech., B. Pharm, B.Sc., B. P. Th., and MCA. The department also runs MA in English and Ph.D. Program in English Literature and Language and Certificate and Diploma Courses in German, French, Arabic, English and Urdu.

## For Certificate:

Secondary school certificate from ICSE/CBSE/Board of high-school and intermediate or an equivalent examination with not less than 45% marks in the aggregate.

# For Diploma:

Certificate of proficiency in the concerned language or an equivalent examination with not less than 45% marks in the aggregate.

## (D) ELIGIBILITY

Certificate of proficiency in the concerned language or an equivalent examination with not less than 45% marks in the aggregate.

# (E) MODE OF ADMISSION

100% of the total intake shall be filled on the basis of the merit of the qualifying examination.

# (F) ADMISSION

The list of the eligible candidates for admission counseling to Certificate courses shall be displayed on Notice Board/ Website of the University on 6 June, 2016. However, the intimation letter shall be sent to eligible candidates only for communicating the date of counseling on which they have to report for completing the admission formalities.

# (G) RESERVATION

50% of the total intake is reserved for the minority community.

# (A)COURSES OF STUDY

#### (B) ELIGIBILITY

M.A. (English): B.A. in English as one of the subjects (up to 3<sup>rd</sup> year) with a minimum of 50% marks in the aggregate from a recognized university.

#### Note:-

B.Sc., B.Com. & B. Tech. Graduates can also seek admission to MA in English if they have secured 55% and above marks in their graduation with the sole condition that they will have to clear two papers of Bridge Course in English simultaneously with their MA English Course.

#### (C) MODE OF ADMISSION

100% of the total intake shall be filled on the basis of the merit of the qualifying examination.

#### (D) ADMISSION

The list of the eligible candidates for admission counseling to Post graduate courses shall be displayed on Notice Board/Website of the University on 2 July 2016. However, the intimation letter may be sent to the eligible candidates only for communicating the date of counseling on which they have to report for completing the admission formalities.

# (E) RESERVATION

50% of the total intake is reserved for the minority community.

The notification for PhD (Doctor of Philosophy in English) is released in the months of Dec/ Mar, and the students are required to qualify an entrance test and subsequently appear for an interview.

## PhD (Doctor of Philosophy) in English

Postgraduate in English with a minimum of 55% or Grade Point of 6.25

# MODE OF ADMISSION

The admission to MA in English is on the basis of merit (i.e. marks obtained). The notification for PhD (Doctor of Philosophy) in English is released in the months of June and July. The students are required to qualify an entrance test and subsequently appear for an interview

## Language Lab

The department has a well-equipped state-of-the-art Language Lab that provides Computer- Aided Language Learning (CALL) to the Engineering students. The Language Lab is equipped with ODLL Software.
