The **Spoken Tutorial project** is funded by the **National Mission on Education through ICT, MHRD**. The Spoken Tutorial Project is about teaching and learning a particular FOSS (Free and Open Source Software) and covers many useful IT topics, such as Basic IT Literacy, Tux Typing, K Turtle, C, C++, Java, PHP, Linux, Scilab, Python, Open FOAM, PERL, Ruby, Libre Office, Blender, GeoGebra, Jmol, GChemPaint and Inkscape. There are about 630 original spoken tutorials, created in English. These videos are dubbed into all 22 Indian languages.

"Integral University agreed to include Spoken Tutorials as MOOCs for practical courses, wherever possible". So far the University conducted about **88 trainings** in which **15017**students participated.
