ORDINANCE

BA Honours English

Effective from July 2018

1. ELIGIBILITY

1.1 A candidate seeking admission to the BA Honours English program of Integral University, Lucknow, must hold a 10+2 from a recognized Board/ School.

1.2 He/She should have 45% marks at the 10+2 level. SC/ST candidates should have atleast 40% marks at the 10+2 level.

1.3 For conditions not specified in clauses 1.1 and 1.2 above, the eligibility criteria/ guidelines prescribed and/or issued by University Grants Commission UGC or any other such statutory bodies, from time to time pertaining to said disciplines/ courses may be considered as minimum requirements for registration to the BA Honours English program of the University.

2.ADMISSION

2.1

The total number of seats available in any academic year shall be advertised. The admission shall be made on the basis of marks obtained.

2.2

The candidate seeking admission to the BA Honours English program must apply to the University in the prescribed application form.

3.REGISTRATION

3.1

A candidate shall be registered for BA Honours English program in the qualifying examination as stated in the clause "Eligibility".

3.2

Registration of candidates who have been selected for admission shall be made on the payment of the prescribed fee to the University. The fee has to be paid before the beginning of the semester. The program will be considered to commence from the first semester for which the fee has been paid.

4.DURATION OF THE PROGRAM

4.1

The duration of the BA Honours English program is three years.

4.2

If the attendance of a candidate is not up to the mark as per HoD's report he/ she may not be allowed to appear for the examination.

5.EXAMINATION

5.1

All the candidates admitted to BA Honours English program shall be required to pass all the courses. Passing marks for all courses are 40%. Optional subjects shall be decided in consultation with the HoD/Departmental coordinator.

5.2

Evaluation of progress of the candidates shall be done through examinations which will be held at the end of each semester. Candidates are expected to pass all the

courses pertaining to each semester. However, they maybe permitted one more attempt to pass the failed courses, in the next consecutive semester.
