Dr. Mohammad Zafar Idris has joined Integral Institute of Medical Sciences and Research as Dean, Faculty of Medicine and Director, IIMS&R in July 2015.

Dr. Zafar is alumnus of prestigious King George Medical College, now Medical University. He graduated in Medicine in the year 1973 and completed his post-graduation in Community Medicine in the year 1977, was appointed Lecturer/Assistant Professor and promoted to post of Associate Professor, Professor and Head of the Department in the same college/University and has voluntarily retired in September 2012.

Dr. Zafar was awarded Common Wealth Scholarship in the year 1990 and has successfully completed certificate course in Maternal and Child Health from Liverpool School of Tropical Medicine, affiliated to Liverpool University, United Kingdom.
