Important Notes:

- Student who do NOT attain the minimum required attendance as per University guidelines will NOT be allowed to appear in the Mid Semesters / End Semester / Annual examination
- It is mandatory for all students to appear in both Mid Semester Exams. Average of both mid semester marks shall be taken for computation purpose.
- Students who wish to appear in the Improvement Exam, need to apply for the same for individual subjects. The fee for the Improvement Exam is Rs. 2000/- per subject.
- The Improvement Exam shall act as a "Substitute" for any one of the Mid Semester exam for that particular subject.
- For a student, who has appeared in the two Mid Semester exams and also in the Improvement Exam for a particular subject, the average of two best scores would be considered.
- Mid Semester exam copies to be shown to the students within one week of the completion of exams.
- Educational Tours may be arranged during winter vacation.
- Students are advised to deposit their fee at the earliest to avoid the long queues on later days.
- Admit Card for appearing in End Semester Examination would only be given to students after deposition of second installment of the fee.
