The article mentioned false and fabricated information regarding the health of some of the students. The University strongly condemns the fake information. Contrary to the claims made in the said article, it is to be noted that neither the CDO nor any member of his team has visited the University. All students are healthy and are exercising precautions as per the directives of the government. Further, the report that the students have been found to carry symptoms of any disease is totally false. No team of the Health Department of the State Government is involved in any investigation. The hostels are self-sufficient, and students have no movement outside. As such the published article is totally baseless, fake and fabricated.

Further with reference to the article published in Hindustan at Page 8 on 1st April, 2020, the said students are bonafide students of Integral University and regular residents of the hostel. They have been staying in the hostel since atleast two years. No person from outside has been allowed to stay in the University hostel with the students.

The University urges all parents and students to stay calm and to not believe rumours designed to create panic in the society.
