#### Deeksharambh, Vriksharopan Jan Abhiyan 2024 and City Tour

Deeksharambh – Student Induction Program was held for first year students admitted to the UG and PG programs at the FoAPD, IIPSR in the 1<sup>st</sup> week of August 2024. To commemorate the "Vriksharopan Jan Abhiyan 2024" launched by Shri Yogi Adityanath, Hon. Chief Minister of Uttar Pradesh, saplings were planted at Integral University Phase-3 Campus. # **Teacher Training Program In Collaboration with Council of Architecture Training & Research Centre, Pune**

In collaboration with Council of Architecture Training & Research Centre, Pune, Faculty of Architecture, Planning & Design, Integral Institute Of Professional Studies & Research, Phase-III, Integral University, Lucknow organized a 05-Day Online Teachers Training Program on *Academic Writing in the Domains of Architecture & Design* between 21<sup>st</sup> April 2025 – 25<sup>th</sup> April 2025 . The Teachers Training Program was aimed to enhance the knowledge of Teachers and Researchers and to encourage them to write effectively and eloquently.

The key objectives of the programme were Enhancing Writing Skills, Understanding Academic Conventions, Ethical Writing Practices, Publishing and Presentation Skills and Use of Artificial Intelligence. The Program was convened by Prof. Jayashree Deshpande, Director COA-TRC, Pune.

#### **Educational Tour**

Participation of 12 prominent companies highlighted the collaborative efforts between academia and industry.



# **QILA RAJA MAHMUDABAD**

Mahmudabad was one of the largest Taluqdaris under the Mughal rule and the House of Mahmudabad trace their lineage to the Banu Taim - the tribe of the first Caliph of Islam, Abu Bakr.

The family finally settled in Mahmudabad in the 16th century - named after Nawab Mahmud Khan, who was invested with robes of honour and heredity titles of Nawab and Khan Bahadur by Emperor Akbar for showing exemplary courage in battle.

In 1857, Muqimuddaulah Raja Nawab Ali Khan of Mahmudabad supported Begum Hazrat Mahal in the rebellion against the British. He was fatally wounded and martyred on the battlefield. The Kothi was completely destroyed in the uprising and the Qila, as it stands today was reconstructed immediately thereafter, on the original foundations.

The Kothi of the Qila is divided into the ladies' apartments or the 'mahalsara' and the men's apartments or 'mardana', where Muqim Manzil and Tedhi Kothi are located. There is a family mosque in the Qila as well as a number of Imambadas.

- The **Mahmudabad Estate** opens the doors to its forts in <u>Mahmudabad and Bilehra</u> and, its city residence in Lucknow to visitors who wish to explore Awadh's culture and traditions.
- The Mahmudabad Estate was founded in 1677 by Raja Mahmud Khan, a descendant of the First Caliph of Islam.
- The Kothi, or palace, is part of a **10-acre** complex called the <u>Qila, or fort</u>.


# LUCKNOW TIMES FASHION WEEK 2025

The Act provides for registration of Architects, standards of education, recognized qualifications and standards of practice to be complied with by the practicing architects. The COA oversees the maintenance of the standards periodically by way of conducting inspections through Committees of Experts.

- 3D Printer Lab: The department has cutting-edge technology in 3D Printing facility at the university workshop.
- CNC 8 Laser Cutting Lab: In the university workshop latest machinery for laser cutting and CNC is available for model making.

- **Textile lab:** Well-equipped lab with necessary tools for textile studies.


