"Report on Awareness Program to Hear the Voice of Youth"

Department of Commerce, Faculty of Commerce & Management organized an awareness programme to brief & sensitize the students about the **'Viksit Bharat @2047 Abhiyan'** a flagship initiative of the Hon'ble Prime Minister of India Shri Narendra Modi for making India a completely developed nation by 2047 i.e. 100 years after independence. The government in its vision document for 'Viksit Bharat @2047' has stated that the core objective of the Viksit Bharat vision is to foster inclusive economic participation among all citizens.

Prof Adeel Maqbool, Vice-Dean, FCM underlined the key aspects of the 'Viksit Bharat' vision document and informed that one of its main aim is to turn India to a \$30-trillion developed economy in about two decades for a projected 1.65 billion populations. He further stated that the 'Viksit Bharat' vision document envisions economic growth, sustainable development goals, improvements in the ease of living and doing business and also takes into account four major factors likely to take centre stage by 2050: India and Africa's increasing prominence on the global stage, reflecting PM Modi's emphasis on the Global South at G20; a world marked by growing affluence but also polarization; escalating climate crises; and a rapidly changing geopolitical landscape.

Dr Farhina Sardar Khan, Programme Convener informed the students that Hon'ble Prime Minister has called upon the youth of the country to play a pivotal role in this nation building exercise and contribute to the vision of Viksit Bharat @ 2047. She informed that our university is very actively involved in this campaign under the supervision of our Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor. She also urged the students to share their vision of Viksit Bharat@ 2047 & submit a write-up on specific themes that how the trade & commerce is instrumental in integrating the economy of Bharat with that of the world, secondly how transport infrastructure & logistics is navigating the future & furthering sustainable growth and how the world class financial sector of Bharat is supporting capital formation, promoting trade & business and providing insurance protection & retirement security to all its citizens.
