Department of Commerce & Management, Faculty of Commerce & Management, in Association with Internal Quality Assurance cell (IQAC) organized a 2 day Faculty Development program (FDP) on "Research Projects: Submitting Proposal & Seeking Grants" on 2nd & 3rd of March 2020, in Central Auditorium. The session was presided by Professor Asiya Chaudhary, Department of Commerce, Aligarh Muslim University, an eminent speaker and educationist in the field.

Prof. Asiya Chaudhary, is Life Member of The Textiles Association (India), Mumbai. She is also Member of The Committee to Monitor the Academic Progression & University Ranking, Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC), Aligarh Muslim University, Aligarh. She is Chief Coordinator, Centre for United Nations Chapter, established in the Department of Commerce, Aligarh Muslim University, Aligarh, Selected in the panel of Associate Professor, of Finance & Accounting for the Council's Chair of ICCR (Indian Council for Cultural Relation), New Delhi.

The program started by felicitating the eminent guests with bouquets, by our volunteers followed by welcome note by Dean FCM Prof Anoop Kumar Saxena. One of the major topics of Prof. Asiya was the evaluation of such reports by the evaluators, as what is being sought and examined by evaluators. This gave students, the first hand knowledge, as how to refine their work. She approached and explained the topics very professionally and guided the students with her wisdom, thru the whole session.

The report and thesis writing was explained in micro and medium with single agenda, as how to deliver the experience best in word and numbers, which can play a major role in future building, once the conclusions are implemented.

Prof Asiya highlighted the importance of the funding required for good research projects. This was a very major part of her knowledge of the day. She tried her best to cover the resource and funding aspect, to very depth of the topic and explained the approach and avenues, one should take to initiate, execute and conclude the research, with enough funding from proper and professional sources. The consequences, in all scenarios, were well detailed, as she has vast experience in the field of research and education. She supported her topic with live examples and took some case studies too.
