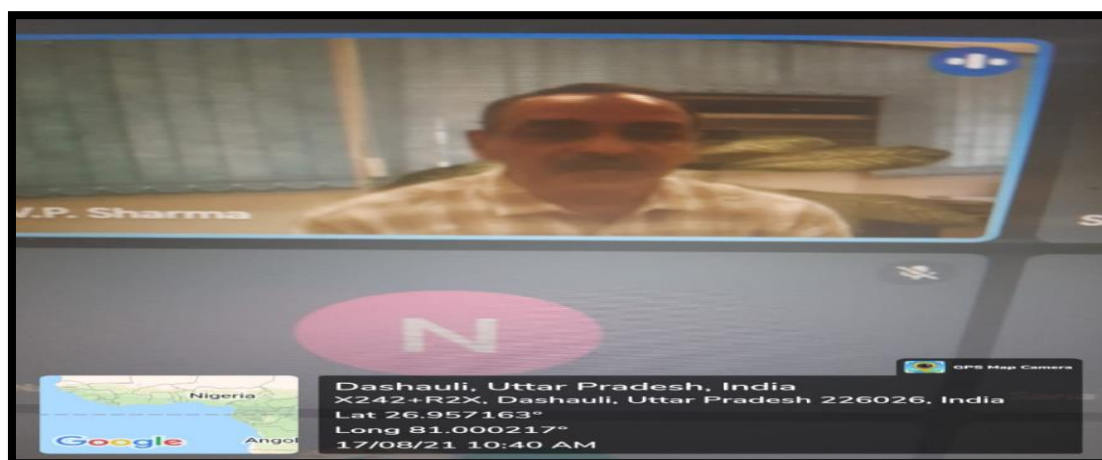
**“Waste Management, Degradable and Non-degradable:
