## Report on "SUMMER SCHOOL 2025"

The Summer School 2025, organized by the Centre for Career Guidance and Development (CCG&D) at Integral University, was a dynamic and career enrichment program. Its primary aim was to equip students with essential skills that are crucial for personal growth, academic advancement, and future employability. Designed to address multiple areas of student development, the program offered intensive training in English communication, Aptitude development, Personality grooming, and Interview preparation. It created a vibrant platform where students could learn, interact, and grow in a supportive and well-structured environment. What set this initiative apart was its inclusive nature, drawing participation from a diverse group of learners, including international students. Through expert-led sessions and hands-on activities, the program successfully fostered self-confidence, practical knowledge, and clarity in career planning.

The Summer School commenced on **Wednesday**, **11th June 2025**, with an enthusiastic audience of around 70 students on the **inaugural day**. The event began with a warm welcome address by Ms. Shahana Khan from CCG&D, followed by an inspiring speech from **Dr. Nilanjan Mukherji** (**Director-CCG&D**), who highlighted the importance of communication and logical aptitude for academic and professional growth. An engaging ice-breaking session helped students connect and build rapport.

**Ms. Shahana Khan** conducted the English communication module, focusing on spoken English, grammar, sentence construction, and pronunciation. Her sessions emphasized practical usage and interaction to build confidence among students. These sessions were complemented by the **seminar** held on **25th June 2025** on *English Communication for Career Progression*, where **Mr. Ervin Das**, a renowned IELTS expert, and **Mr. Fahad** engaged students through activities such as article usage, pronunciation exercises, sentence-building tasks, and an introduction to the IELTS framework. Mr. Das's innovative approach using Hindi alphabets to explain English article usage was particularly appreciated. Mr. Fahad further guided the students on IELTS preparation and global opportunities. The seminar left students inspired to enhance their communication skills for academic and professional excellence.

The aptitude development sessions were led by Mr. Ayaz Mehmood and Mr. Shaz Alam, who trained students in quantitative aptitude, logical reasoning, and analytical problem-solving. Their teaching included tips and techniques for tackling competitive exams efficiently. Additionally, students benefited from a seminar held on 25th June 2025 titled Exploring Careers in the Public and Government Sectors, conducted by Physics Wallah with speakers Mr. Ravindra Tripathi (Branch Head) and Mr. Shubham (Maths Expert). Mr. Tripathi introduced the role of aptitude in

competitive exams, while Mr. Shubham demonstrated fast-calculation tricks, square root shortcuts, and other problem-solving strategies. The session was highly interactive and significantly improved students 'aptitude-solving confidence and speed.
