Report: Visit to the Center for Career Guidance and Development (CCG&D) by First-Year Students under the Orientation Program

As part of the **Orientation Program 2025**, all departments at Integral University organized structured visits for newly admitted first-year students to the **Center for Career Guidance and Development (CCG&D)** from **July 31st to August 2nd, 2025**. These sessions were designed to introduce students to the University's career progression & support system and to help them understand the resources available for their academic and professional development.

The **primary objective** was to familiarize students with the roles, services, and future engagement opportunities offered by CCG&D. The visit was aimed at creating career awareness among students and encouraging them to begin strategic planning for their careers from the very start of their University journey.

Visit Details-

According to the schedule, students from various departments attended orientation sessions in batches over three days. The sessions were held mostly in the CCG&D Hall and also at the Central Auditorium, scheduled mutually by the concerned departments in coordination with CCG&D.

 Biosciences, Computer Applications (CA)
- August 2, 2025 (Saturday):
 Department of Agriculture and School of Pharmaceutical Sciences (SPS)

Each session commenced with a welcome address by **Dr. Nilanjan Mukherji (Director-CCG&D)**, who shared the vision of the center. He provided an in-depth overview of the career guidance services, training programs, and placement support available through CCG&D. Emphasis was also placed on the importance of English proficiency and Aptitude development, along with regular participation in seminars, workshops, and alumni interaction sessions.

Director – CCG&D also introduced the entire team, explaining the roles of individual members and how each contributes to students' academic and career success.
