REPORT ON SUMMER SCHOOL 2026.

Programme Highlights

Summer School 2026 comprised two major training modules: **Soft Skills & Career Readiness** and **Aptitude & Reasoning**.

The **Soft Skills & Career Readiness** module was conducted by **Ms. Shahana Khan (Communication Trainer)** and **Dr. Sufia Rehman (Training & Placement Officer)**. The module focused on enhancing students' communication, interpersonal, and professional competencies through the following topics:

Aptitude & Reasoning

The **Aptitude & Reasoning** module was conducted by **Mr. Ayaz Mehmood** and **Mr. Shaz Aalam (Aptitude Trainers)**. The module covered essential quantitative aptitude and logical reasoning topics, including:

- Coding-Decoding
- Number System
- Number Series
- HCF & LCM
- Profit & Loss
- Permutation & Combination
- Blood Relations
- Syllogism
- Time & Work
- Clock
- Alligation & Mixture
- Calendar

The programme adopted an interactive and learner-centered approach that included presentations, group discussions, role plays, aptitude practice, communication activities, and practical exercises. These activities encouraged active participation, collaborative learning, and the practical application of concepts in real-life situations.

Evaluation & Assessment

Students' learning and overall performance were evaluated through both Soft Skills and Aptitude & Reasoning assessments.

Soft Skills & Career Readiness Assessment:

- Individual presentations on assigned topics
- Evaluation of communication skills and presentation delivery
- Observation of confidence, voice modulation, and body language
- Formal dress code and professional appearance
- Overall presentation and interpersonal skills

Aptitude & Reasoning Assessment:

- Online aptitude test conducted through Wayground (formerly Mentimeter)
- Assessment of quantitative aptitude, logical reasoning, and analytical abilities
- Evaluation based on accuracy, problem-solving skills, and overall performance

The assessment process provided students with constructive feedback on their strengths and areas for improvement, enabling them to enhance their communication skills, professional confidence, and aptitude for placement and competitive examinations.

Programme Coordination

The programme was organized under the guidance and leadership of **Dr. Zishan Raza Khan (Director In charge-CCG&D)**. To support the smooth execution of the programme, **Mohamad Ashjaa Khan** and **Anamika Singh**, students of **B.Tech. (Computer Science & Engineering – DSAI)-final year**, served as student **mentors**. They assisted in participant coordination, classroom management, attendance, communication between trainers and participants, and other organizational

activities, contributing significantly to the successful conduct of the programme.

The programme significantly enhanced students' communication skills, confidence, aptitude, reasoning ability, teamwork, leadership qualities, and professional behavior. It also improved their readiness for campus placements through resume building, interview preparation, and workplace communication training. 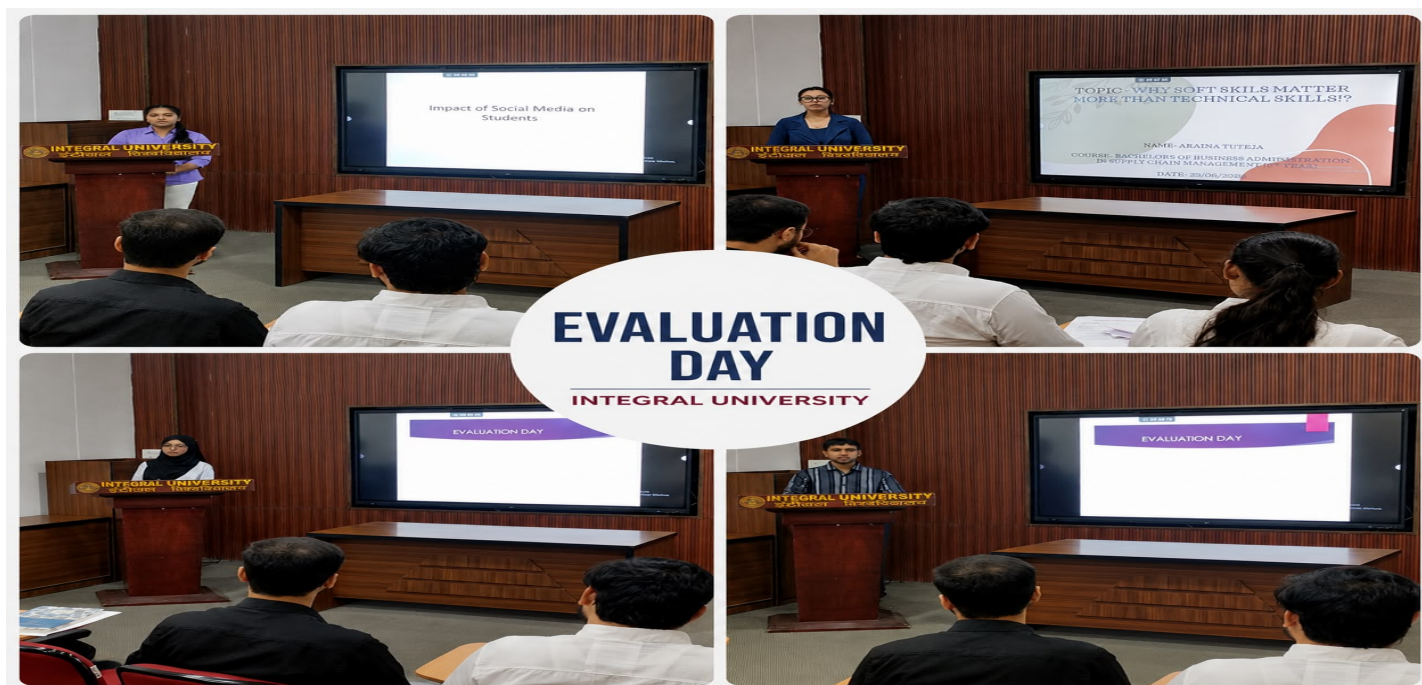
