

Introduction of Product Patent in India

- In 2005, India took pride in being the "pharmacy of the world" with the country being the source of cheaper lifesaving medicines for millions across the world. For instance, during the AIDS crisis, India's generic antiretroviral drugs, such as, AIDS triple therapy – which used to cost **US\$10,000 per patient per year in the West – was made available at less than US\$200 per year**
- India's 1970 Patents Act, inter alia, disallowed product patent on **food, beverage, medicine, and chemicals**. Even though process patent was allowed, its term was supplemented by a broad "license of right" regime which was granted to anyone who sought to use the patented process three years after the sealing of the patent
- Freed from the fetter of product patent, Indian domestic pharma sector in collaboration with government laboratories could manufacture the latest drugs and introduce them at a fraction of international prices
