TARGETED DEVICE : Software like VLC, AnyDesk, OBS, Trading applications

IMPACT : Gain access and steal the sensitive information like account credentials

REMEDIES : Must follow safe practices while browsing and also do not visit unauthorized websites or do not download software from untrusted sources.

TARGETED DEVICE : Firewalls, Routers and DVR/cameras

IMPACT: Gain access to the device

REMEDIES : Keep software up to date, Use proper configured firewall

TARGETED DEVICE: Linux servers

IMPACT : Access into the system with the help of stealing credentials like username and password

REMEDIES : Use complex passwords, multi factor authentication system

TARGETED DEVICE: Linux and Windows

IMPACT: It will traversed through victim network and stole information for extortion

REMEDIES : Maintain offline backup of data, Backup data must be encrypted and mutable

TARGETED DEVICE: Google Play Store

IMPACT : Eight android applications are infected, subscribe users to premium & illegal accessing to SMS messages.

REMEDIES : As soon as the information received, delete those infected application. User consent to the application is very important

TARGETED DEVICE: Windows

IMPACT: Steals the sensitive data of the system

REMEDIES : Maintain offline backup of data, Backup data must be encrypted and mutable.



SCAM ALERT



Do not respond to spam mails without verification of the e-mail origin



Avoid job offers that ask you to deposit money



APPOINTMENT ORDER



Always prefer for personal interview. Scammers also conduct telephonic interview, which can be fake/risky



Check for spelling mistakes. Fake job offer mails generally have spelling mistakes and grammatical errors

BEWARE OF FAKE JOB OFFERS



Do not believe in emails received from personal mail id. Authentic job offers are sent from company registered emails



Never believe in the job offer to which you have not applied or if they ask for your personal information/bank details
