






COUNTRIES ARE MOST INTERESTED IN

The European Commission calls deepfakes a "global crisis" with "implications for data security, privacy, and intellectual property rights.

The country most interested in deepfakes is South Korea, where there have been 13,399 searches per million people.




Methodology: We calculated Google search volume data for the top 100 deepfake-related keywords by country relative to the number of Internet users and the market share of Google search in each country
