General Rules

- Participants must adhere to design theme (5th National Pharmacovigilance week- **Your Safety, Just a Click Away: Report to PvPI**).
- Only specific materials may be allowed, such as colored powders, flowers, rice, or other natural materials.
- The work area must be kept clean during and after the competition.
- Scattered materials or an untidy workspace may affect the final score.
- The Rangoli must be freehand and created on-site during the competition.
- Participants must create their Rangoli in a designated group (Max. 6/group).
- Avoid harmful chemicals or materials that may damage the environment.
