


Constitution Day

The Department of Biosciences has been granted the prestigious Funding for Infrastructure in Science and Technology (FIST) by the Department of Science and Technology, Ministry of Science and Technology, Government of India. The DST-FIST award is granted to Departments with high research calibre and excellent performance of the students graduating from the department as evidenced through extramural funding attracted by the faculty, high-impact research publication, and selection of students for national fellowships and scholarships.


Adviser and G-grade scientist Dr. A. Mukhopadhyay in a letter to the university has said that the proposal of the university has been accepted for support under the Fund for Improvement of Science and Technology (FIST) to strengthen the research facilities in the department. The support of the university, being a private academic institution, will be shared on a 50:50 basis.

As part of the award, the Department of Biosciences will be given funding for infrastructure and high-end instruments to the tune of Rs. 58 lakh. The long-drawn process for getting this award involved stringent screening of application, which was followed by a presentation before an empowered commitee 'FIST Advisory Board' (FISTAB) of DST at its office in New Delhi.

The Department of Biosciences took the mantle of achieving this feat, which was a cherished desire of our Revered Chancellor, Prof. Syed Waseem Akhtar, upon itself, and had been doing the groundwork for the same for the past two years. It is with his blessings and encouragement that the department has emerged successful. Road and Traffic Safety Campaign From 22 to 25 January 2018

The Department of Environmental Science, Integral University, Lucknow in association with Pacific Institute of Safety and Health jointly organized a four-day awareness drive from 22-25th January 2018 on "Road and Traffic Safety" to make people aware of traffic accidents and their impact on country's economy. Prof. M. A. Khalid, Head, Department of Environmental Science gave brief background about the programme and collaborating organization and delivered a talk about road safety and traffic ethics in European countries. He mentioned about Sweden's roads, which are considered the world's safest roads with an estimated 3.0 road traffic deaths per 100,000 people and said that the roads in the Dominican Republic were found to be least safe for vehicle drivers. He emphasized about the new challenges such as use of mobile phones and digital devices while driving and said that the biggest challenge that countries all over the world is facing nowadays is to bring down the number of road casualties. This was followed by a lecture delivered by Mr. Mohammad Shahid Siddiqui, Director of Pacific Institute of Safety and Health. He informed that India is one of the biggest losers of its young man power/ human resource and economy because of the road accidents, where annually more than 1.5 lakh people die and Rs 50,000 crores are lost because of road accidents. It was followed by an awareness drive through road show in the university campus and at various places in Lucknow during the four days.


