

## CENTRE FOR DISTANCE & ONLINE EDUCATION XVII- Convocation, 2025

#### Dear Students,

The criteria for awarding medals during the convocation ceremony are outlined below, followed by the list of medal recipients for the XVII Convocation, 2025. Please review the information carefully and report any discrepancies to the Deputy Director (DDE) at **dde@iul.ac.in** by **October 24**, 2025, positively. No applications or claims will be entertained after this date.

#### Category of Medals:

- a. University Toppers (only from Degree programs in full time regular mode, not from online, part time or evening programs):
- 1. Gold medal for the first position in the university
- 2. Silver Medal for the second position in the university
- b. In the Faculty (only from Degree programs in full time regular mode, not from online, part time or evening programs):
- 1. Gold medal for the first position in the Faculty
- 2. Silver Medal for the Second position in the Faculty
- c. In the program:
- 1. Gold medal for the First position
- 2. Sivel medal for the second position

#### **Criteria for Awarding Medals:**

#### Eligibility:

- 1. Medals shall be considered only for regular full-time programs (not part-time or evening programs).
- 2. The number of outgoing students in a program must be at least five, except in regulatory programs with less than five but more than two sanctioned intakes (e.g., MS/MD in IIMSR).
- 3. Only students admitted in the first year of the program shall be eligible (Students admitted through lateral entry will not be considered).

#### **Basis of Award:**

- 1. Medals will be awarded on the basis of the highest CGPA in CBCS programs and the highest percentage of marks in non-CBCS programs.
- 2. In case of the same CGPA, toppers will be determined on the basis of the highest percentage of marks.
- 3. If both CGPA and percentage of marks are the same, medals shall be awarded to both students.
- 4. In the case of University and Faculty Toppers, if the toppers belong to two different categories, i.e., CBCS and Non-CBCS programs, where the percentage is calculated based on CGPA and obtained marks, respectively, the topper will be selected based on the percentage of total obtained marks.
- 5. The student must have passed all examinations in a single attempt, without grace marks, and with no back or carryover papers.
