FOR MASTER OF ARCHITECTURE
(2-year Full-Time and 3-year Part-Time Programmes)

1. ADMISSION:

1. Admission to the first semester of 2-year Full-Time/3-year Part-Time M.Arch. courses shall be made as per rules formulated by the Integral University.

2. ELIGIBILITY:

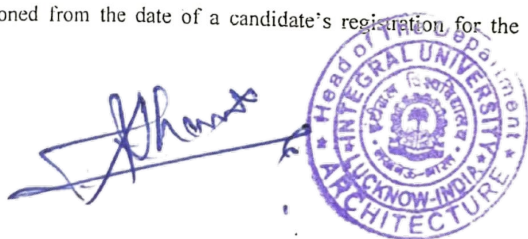
- 2.1. Candidates, who have passed B. Arch. Degree Examination with at least 55% marks, shall be eligible to join these programmes.
- 2.2. The admission to 3-year Part-Time course shall be open to only the Faculty members of Teaching Institutions.

3. DURATION OF THE PROGRAMMES:

- 3.1. The duration of the 2-year Full-Time M.Arch. Programme shall be 4 Semesters and that of 3-year Part-Time M.Arch. Programme 6 Semesters.
- 3.2. Each semester shall be of a minimum of 90 working days.
- 3.3. In addition to self-study, the 2-year Full-Time students shall attend coursework for 486 hrs. /Semester, i.e., 27 hrs / week and 3-year Part-Time M.Arch. shall attend coursework for 326 hrs. / Semester, i.e., 18 hours / week.
- 3.4. Student of 2-year Full-Time and 3-year Part-Time M.Arch. Programmes shall be required to complete the programme in a maximum of 4 years and 5 years respectively from the date of their joining the programme.

4. ATTENDANCE:

- 4.1. Though each student is normally required to attend all lectures, tutorials, studio classes, educational tours and seminars, an attendance of 75% in each and every subject is compulsory failing which a student shall be detained from taking the examination of that semester.. However, the Dean/ Head of Department may allow a relaxation of 15% in attendance in deserving cases.
- 4.2. The attendance of a student shall be reckoned from the date of a candidate's registration for the respective course.



5. CURRICULUM:

5.1. The curriculums of the 2-year Full-Time M.Arch. and 3-year Part-Time M.Arch. programmes shall include lectures, tutorials, seminars and educational tours as shown in the Scheme of Teaching and Examinations given in **Annexure – I** and **Annexure – II** respectively.

6. EXAMINATIONS:

6.1. A student's performance in 2-year Full-Time M.Arch. and 3-year Part-Time M.Arch. programmes shall be evaluated for sessionals through continuous assessment in class tests, assignments, and viva-voce/jury etc. A semester examination shall be held after every semester as per Scheme of Examinations given in **Annexure – I** and **Annexure – II** respectively.

6.2. The distribution of marks for sessionals and semester examination for 2-year Full-Time M.Arch. and 3-year Part-Time M.Arch. Programmes shall be as per the prescribed Scheme of Teaching and Examinations (**Annexure – I** and **Annexure – II** respectively).

6.3. A student, who fails in any one subjects including Thesis/Project, may be allowed another chance to clear the same in supplementary examinations, which shall be held normally after one month of the announcement of results of the **even** semester examination.

6.4* A student, who fails to obtain the minimum qualifying marks in sessionals in each and every subject or aggregate of examination (even after the supplementary examination), shall have to repeat the semester as a regular student except in the major two subjects of MAR – 301 and MAR – 401, having viva-voce examination. In such cases of the shortage in sessionals as per clause 7.1.1, the student shall be awarded a supplementary in the sessional of the subject and shall be allowed to take the supplementary viva-voce examination (to be conducted within 2 months) only after he/she has attained a minimum of 50% marks in the sessionals of the above said subjects. However, such students may be provisionally allowed to take the examinations of the other subjects as per the Examination Schedule.

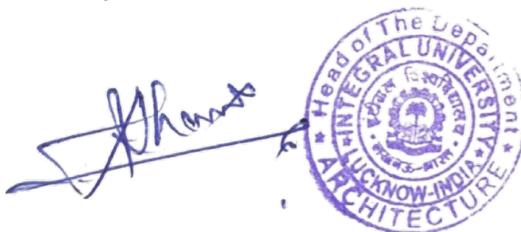
6.5 The marks awarded to a candidate in a subject in the supplementary examination shall be the arithmetic mean of the minimum pass marks and the marks secured by the candidate in the supplementary examination.

7. QUALIFYING STANDARDS:

7.1. The minimum pass marks for qualifying for the next semester shall be as under:

7.1.1. Sessionals :	50% in each subject
7.1.2. Theory Examination :	50% in each subject
7.1.3. Design Studio Viva Voce /Thesis Jury :	50%

8. AWARD OF DIVISION:



8.1. The division to a student shall be awarded on the basis of a student's final result at the end of the final semester, computed in accordance with the Scheme of Teaching and Examinations.

8.2. The computation of the final result will take into consideration the marks obtained by the student in all semesters where full weightage is given to marks obtained in each and every subject of each semester and consequently, the final result would consist of 6000 marks.

8.3. A student shall be awarded division on the basis of aggregate marks in the final semester inclusive of the carry-over marks in accordance with the Scheme of Teaching & Examinations, as follows:

First Division with Honours: 75% or more marks in the aggregate subject to the condition of a student clearing all examinations in the first attempt.

First Division: 60% or above marks in the aggregate, and

Second Division: < 60% marks in the aggregate

9. THESIS AND PROJECT:

9.1. The Thesis at the end of IV Semester of 2-year Full-Time Programme and at the end of VI Semester of and 3-year Part-Time Programmes shall be evaluated, on presentation by the student, through viva-voce examination, by a jury of five examiners of which two shall be external and three internal examiners. The senior-most internal examiner shall act as Chairman of the jury. A student, who fails to attain qualifying marks, may be allowed to repeat the Thesis/Project.

10. MIGRATION:

10.1 Migration of students to 2-year Full-Time and 3-year part-Time M.Arch. Programmes from other universities, pursuing the same programme, is ordinarily not permitted.

11. CANCELLATION OF ADMISSION:

11.1 The admission of a once-admitted student to the 2-year Full-Time M.Arch. or 3-year Part-Time M.Arch. Programme can be cancelled because of non-payment of fees or any act of indiscipline, deemed so, by the University.
