Master of Science in Nursing Programme (M.Sc. Nursing)

1. Admission

1.1 Admission to M.Sc. Nursing will be made as per the rules prescribed by the Nursing council of India/ Academic Council of Integral University, Lucknow (here-in after called University) from time to time.

2. Eligibility Criteria

- 2.1 For admission of students through written entrance test/on merit basis & interview (as prescribed by the University)
 - a) Candidates who have passed Basic **B.Sc. Nursing**, **B.Sc Hons**. **Nursing** & **P.B.B.Sc.Nursing** from reputed university at least 55% marksin the aggregate as compulsory are eligible for admission to 1st year of **M.Sc. Nursing**.
 - b) Minimum 1 year work experience after Basic B.Sc. Nursing.
 - c) Minimum 1 year work experience prior or after post basic B.Sc. Nursing.
- NRI/left over seats shall be filled on the basis of qualifying examination provided the candidate meets the eligibility criteria.
- 2.2 Student shall be medically fit.
- 2.3 Candidate shall be admitted once in a year.
- 2.4 5% relaxation of marks for SC/ST candidates may be given.

3. Attendance:

- 3.1 Each student is normally required to attend all the lectures & practical of every subject as also the curricular & co-curricular activities.
- 3.2 A student must have minimum 75% attendance in theory & 100% attendance in practical of each subject for appearing in examination.

4 **Programme Duration:**

4.1 The duration of the programme leading to award to M.Sc. Nursing shall be of two academic years (1st October to 30th September).

5 Aims of the Course:-The aim of the postgraduate nursing programme is to:

- 5.1 Prepare post- graduates to assume responsibilities as professional, competent nurses and midwives in providing preventive, promotive, curative & rehabilitative services.
- 5.2 Prepare nurses who can make independent decisions in nursing situations, protect the rights of patient and facilitate individuals and groups in pursuit of health, function in the hospital, community nursing services and conduct research studies in the areas of nursing practices.
- 5.3 They are also expected to assume the role of teacher, supervisor and manager in a clinical / public health setting.

6 Objective of Course:-

- 6.1 To prepare a professional & technically skilled nurse competent to give comprehensive nursing care to the individual, family & community in sickness & health.
- 6.2 To provide opportunities and experiences, which would enable the student to develop and maintain effective interpersonal relationship with professional & non professional personnel.
- 6.3 Develop a team spirit by working with other members of health care team in the promotion of health & prevention of illness restoration of health.
- 6.4 To ensure opportunities for initiation & resourcefulness, sense of responsibility for one self.
- 6.5 Utilize / apply the concepts, theories and principles of nursing science.
- 6.6 Demonstrate advance competence in practice of nursing.
- 6.7 Demonstrate in conduction nursing research interpreting and utilizing the findings from health related research.

7. Annual Intake:

- 7.1 The number of students shall be admitted as approved by the executive council of the University subject to maximum seat sanctioned by the Nursing Council of India.
- 7.2 Admission to programme shall be made only in 1st year & last date of admission shall be 31st October of admission year.

8. Medium of Instruction:

The medium of instruction for all subjects of study & examination shall be English.

9. Organization of the Programme:

9.1 The period 1st October to 30th September shall constitute one academic year.

- 9.2 There shall be minimum 37 weeks shall be devoted for academic activities, excluding 4 weeks for examination & their preparation.
- 9.3 The academic activities shall be carried for minimum 40 hours / week.
- 9.4 The course delivery in each academic year shall be carried out in accordance with minimum hours assigned to each subject & allied activities.

10. Syllabus:

The syllabus of the programme shall contain subject wise content details academic year wise as prescribed Indian Council of Nursing duty approved by Board of Study & Academic Council shall be published separately.

11. Instructions for conduction of examination

- 11.1 Teaching of advanced nursing practice will be integrated with clinical subjects.
- 11.2 A minimum 75% attendance in theory and practical / Clinical in each subject essential for appearing in the examination.
- 11.3 100% attendance in practical / clinical in each clinical area is essential before award of degree.
- 11.4 50% of minimum marks in each theory and practical paper separately is required for passing.
- 11.5 A candidate has to secure minimum of 33% in qualifying subject for passing.
