The promotive policy of the organisation is helpful in inculcation of quality research temperament amongst faculty and students which is absolutely essential to strengthen the knowledge foundation imperative to research. The primary objective of incentivising research is to:

- Enhance the quality of research, development and training programs.
- Enhance funding of research projects and robust research infrastructure.
- Strengthen research collaborations through MoUs with institutions of national and international repute.
- Encourage research ideas with translational value and deliverable driven outcome.

In order to promote the research in the University following encouraging steps are being followed:

For Faculty:

1. Financial support for faculty members in the form of seed money to start their research activities.
2. Financial support and Duty leave to attend conferences.
3. Research Award Scheme (RAS) for faculty members based on excellence in research including projects, publications, patents, other recognition etc as finalized by Research Award Committee. Research Awards in the form of Certificate of Recognition.
4. Loan against sanction to every project in case money is not released by funding agency.
5. Robust and supportive IPR policy for encouragement of faculty to file patents.
6. Infrastructural and maintenance support for research laboratories/equipment in the University.

For Students:

1. Research Awards in the form of Certificate of Recognition for showing outstanding performance.
2. Provision of Teaching Associateships to provide fellowship to Ph.D candidates.
3. Ph.D. students have to publish in (UGC/Scopus/SCI) before submitting the PhD thesis in order to maintain quality of research.
4. To continuously improve and enhance research skills, scholars and mentors are supported by organizing guest lectures and workshops.
5. Training programmes regarding writing grant proposals, financial management of research projects, dissemination of research findings, research paper writing etc. are regularly organised.
