

Report on Water, Environment and Fireworks Protection Awareness Day March 22, 2017

The program on “Water, Environment and Fireworks Protection Awareness Day 2017” was organized jointly by the **Department of Environmental Science and Civil Engineering** on 22nd March, 2017” at Hall No.3, Central Library Building, Integral University, Lucknow.

The program started with the welcome address from **Ms. Neha Mumtaz, Assistant Professor, Department of Civil Engineering**. He also shared his experiences about his global exploration and research efforts in the field of ecology and biodiversity conservation.

Mr. Mohammad Usama, Assistant Professor, Department of Environmental Science in his lecture emphasized about the ill-effects of fireworks and its protection measures. He raised his concerns that fireworks are responsible for accidents and pollution of our environment. Employment of children in such a hazardous job is a serious issue.
