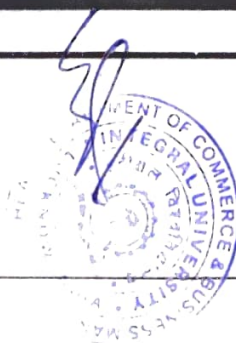

**A Report on
"TWO -DAY Workshop on GOODS AND SERVICES TAX (GST)"
19-20 June, 2021**

Faculty of Commerce and Management, hosted an interactive Two days Workshop on Goods and Services Tax(GST) under the guidance of **Prof. A.K Saxena**, Dean, FCM, and **Dr. Syed Shahid Mazhar**, Head, DCBM, Integral University on June 19 & 20. Chartered Accountant **Mr. Sahil Khan** and Chartered Accountant **Mr. Tafzeel Ahmad Khan** were the Expert Speakers for the sessions.

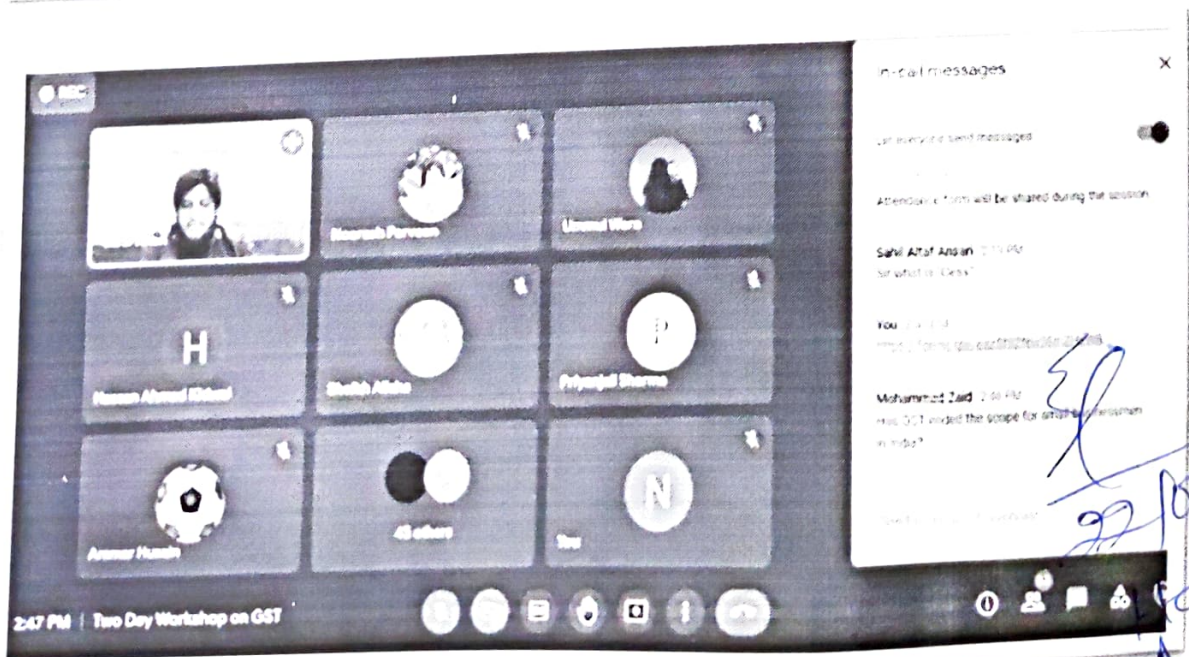
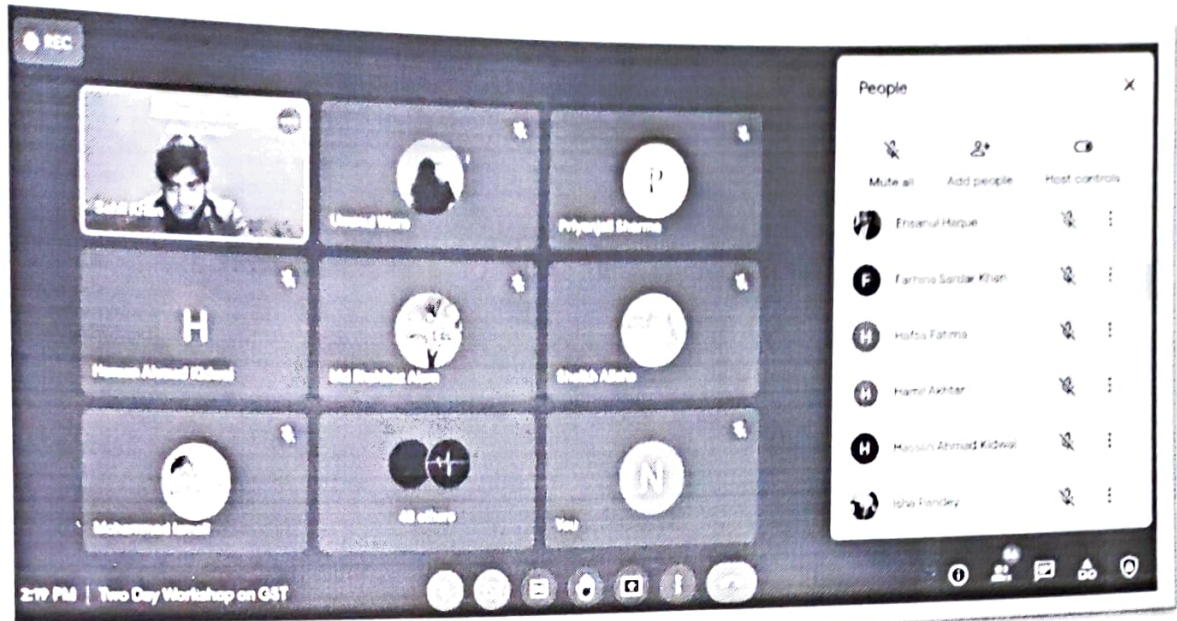
On day one, CA Mr. Sahil Khan provided an in-depth analysis of GST, which is seen as a fundamental overhaul in India's tax system. He began with an informative statement underlining the fundamentals of tax collection with India's federal structure. He highlighted the subtleties of numerous tax concepts such as direct/indirect taxes, regression/progression connected to taxes, and so on, using real-life examples.

On Day two the expert speaker discussed in detail the difficulties of implementing GST in the current economic climate of the country. He explained the key elements of GST, such as the fact that it is a destination-based taxation scheme, from a holistic perspective, taking into account the benefits and drawbacks of each. He demystified the convoluted GST procedure and walked the audience through it systematically. The benefits to the end customer from the implementation of GST were also discussed.

The session benefited about 105 students from the department. The students were excited, they participated with great zeal, and both the sessions concluded with a question and answer round. E-Certificate were issued to all registered participants. The sessions were coordinated and Moderated by Ms. Nazia Akhlaq.

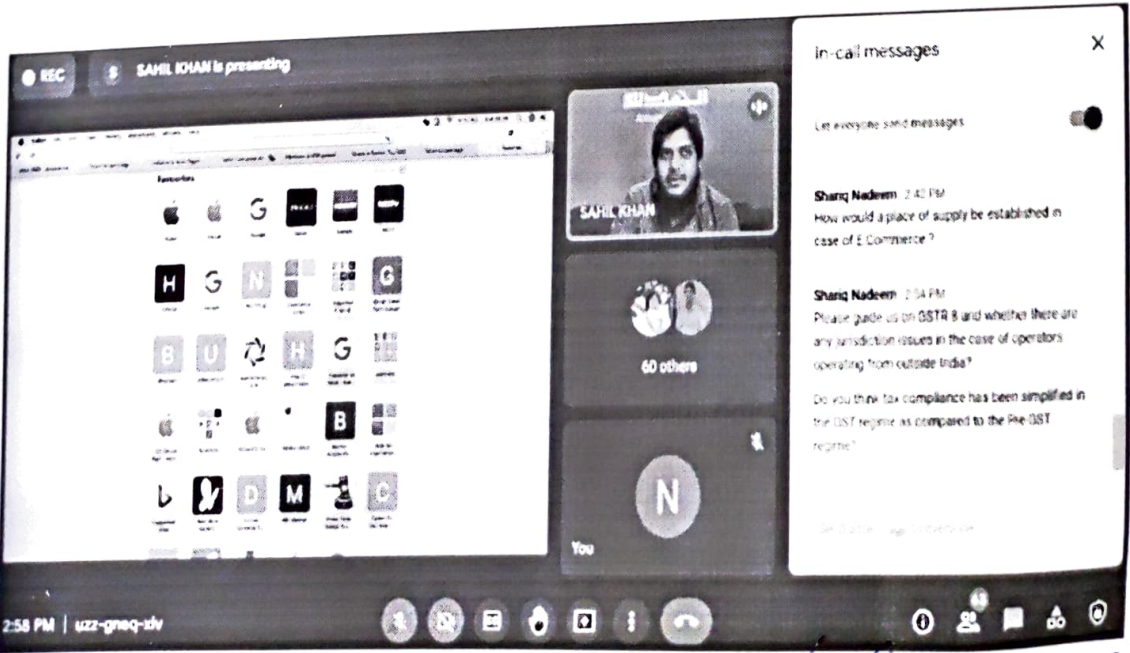
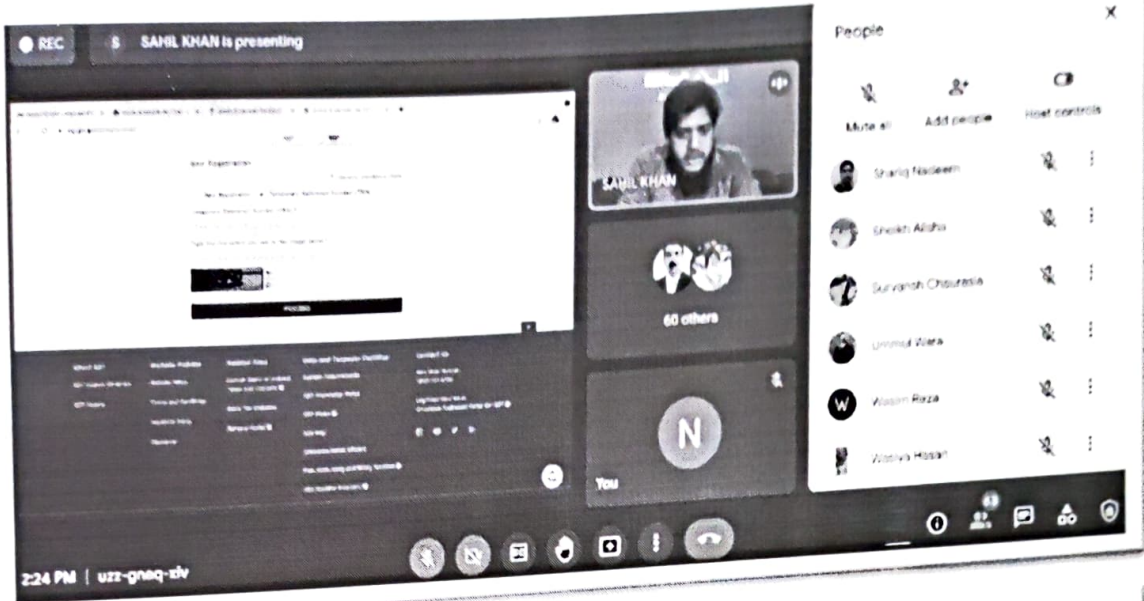
