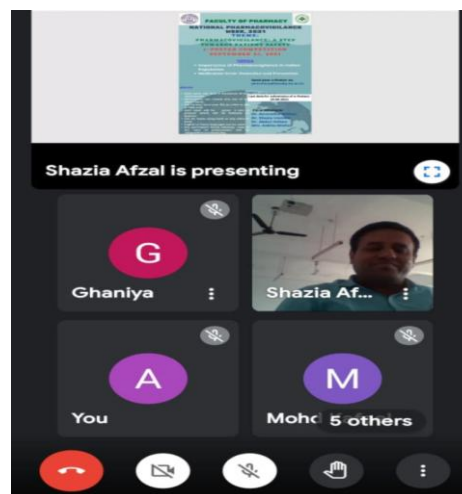
In this context, E-Poster competition is conducted.
