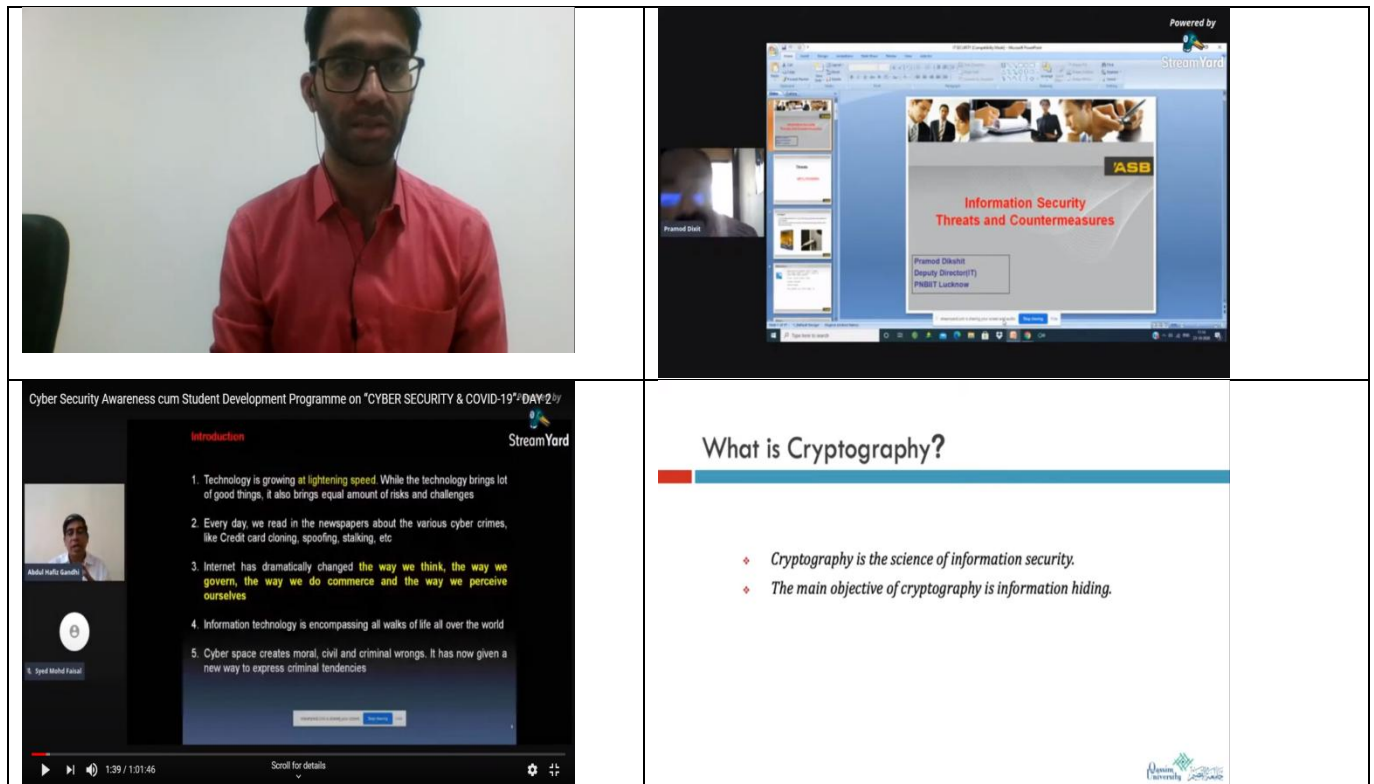
### Cyber Security Awareness cum Student Development Programme (SDP) on “CYBER SECURITY & COVID-19”
