**"How to Read Scientific Literature?" and "Introduction to MANAV-
The Human Atlas Initiative"**

Faculty of Pharmacy under the aegis of **Human Resource Development Centre(HRDC), Integral University**, in association with **DBT-sponsored Project MANAV- Human Atlas Initiative** organized a live interactive session on **"How to Read Scientific Literature?" and "Introduction to MANAV- The Human Atlas Initiative"**.

The session was delivered by **Dr. Anupma Harshal Wadavlikar** who is an educator with teaching expertise of 18 years and a certified trainer for STEM teachers training on Research-Based Pedagogy. She has contributed to several regional RBPT workshops (funded by DBT / DST and CoESME, IISER Pune) across the country, as a subject expert /observer. As a Consultant for Science Communication and Public Engagement she is involved with onboarding, conducting activities for student retention, upskilling thus motivating them to practice higher-level critical thinking skills. Speaker briefed students and faculty members about common misconceptions about scientific literature, differentiated plagiarism and paraphrasing, described various parts of a research article and their ideal contents and approaches to write and understand them. As a unique feature, she also discussed how to read a scientific research article in a short time without losing essence. Students were made aware of project MANAV, an initiative of Department of Biotechnology(DBT), GoI, IISER Pune and Persistent Systems.

The Session concluded with vote of thanks presented by faculty coordinator Dr Anup Kumar Sirbaiya, Associate Professor, Faculty of Pharmacy, Integral University, who congratulated speaker for the wonderful session, moderator Ranjan Kumar for diligent interventions and summarization, thanked collaborators DBT, Persistent systems Inc. and IISER Pune for their support.
