• Counter attacking as soon as possible (or attacking pre-emptively).

• Targeting the body's most vulnerable points.

• Maximum effectiveness and efficiency in order to neutralise the opponents as quickly as possible.

• Developing an awareness of the surroundings while dealing with the threat, look for escape routes or other attackers or objects/weapons to defend

• Understanding the Psychology of confrontation and potential threat.

• Like other martial arts such as Judo, Karate, Taekwondo etc. are form of sports but Krav Maga is pure self-defence art.

Dr. Rizwana Atiq has welcomed the guest. Prof A.K. Saxena, Dean, Faculty of Commerce & Management delivered the welcome address of the workshop. He pointed out that self defence is need of hour. He revealed that he himself is Ex NCC Officer and has undergone three month NCC Pre-Commissioned training Course at Kamttee Nagpur and got Commissioned as second Lieutenant at OTS .After guest speakers talk, Mr. Noor Alam Khan (Coordinator of Workshop), Dr Adeel Maqbool and trainers from strike briefed about workshop then trainers started training students.
