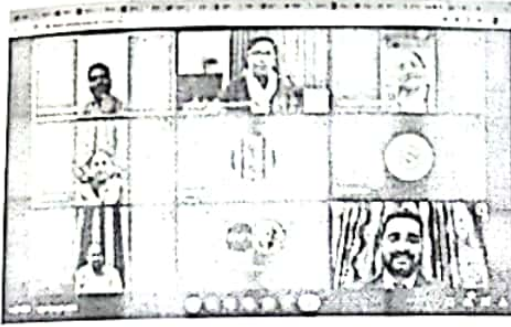
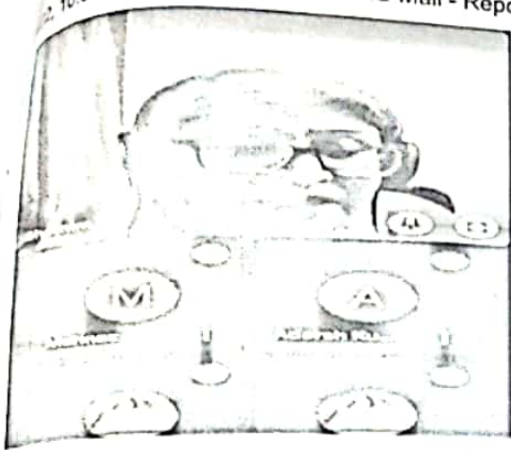
Approximately 180+ Students joined the session and raised so many relevant questions in front of the panel which were well answered by them.
