

A REPORT ON "HOW TO BE A PROLIFIC SCHOLAR" SEPTEMBER 23, 2022

An online Seminar was organized by Faculty of Commerce and Management on the topic "HOW TO BE A PROLIFIC SCHOLAR", September 23, 2022, 09:30 am onwards through the online platform Google Meet under the guidance of Prof. A.K. Saxena Dean, FCM and Dr. S. S. Mazhar, Head, DCBM. The eminent speaker for the session was Dr. James Gaskin, Associate Professor of Information Systems, Brigham Young University in Utah, USA. Prof. A.K Saxena welcomed the eminent speaker and audience in the online seminar. The objective of the Seminar was to encourage scholars to develop the habit of writing and organizing around key sentences, to help scholars become better and more productive researchers. He is probably better known outside of his own field for maintaining the StatWiki and associated YouTube channel "Gaskination" which has millions of views on hundreds of statistics video tutorials.

The speaker explained that some academics seek the assistance of educational developers to improve as better, more productive writers. Some students struggle with productivity. Lack of productivity has detrimental effects on the development of professions and knowledge.

Dr. Gaskin also said that daily writing can help unproductive and productive writers get started. Perhaps asking scholarly writers to write every day is an easy way to get started immediately or to greatly increase a low or moderate level of writing. He said that if you want large numbers of scholars to take writing to the next level, there is no better way than daily writing. He concluded that faculty members should keep assisting scholars and students in becoming better, more productive writers. By assisting scholars, educational innovators, organizations, the corpus of knowledge, the public, and policymakers all can benefit.

The program received a very warm and welcoming response from the faculty and scholars, the audience was very enthusiastic to interact with Prof. James Gaskin in the interactive session, where he answered all the queries of the participants. Total **145 participants** registered for the seminar; the registered participants

were awarded with E-certificate. The program was coordinated by **Dr. Farhina S. Khan and Mr. Shahab Uddin.**






Dr. James Gaskin Delivering his lecture
