## **Awareness-cum-counselling session**

He spoke about the various aspects of Post-selection Business Leadership Enhancement Programme (BLEP) organized at NIFTEM for the selected candidates for enhancement of their competence in safe food business and leadership.

After the talk, platform was open for discussion forum where participants enthusiastically make conversation with Mr. Dave who answered every questions and queries with full energy and also motivated the students and faculty for the active participation.
