The Moot Court and Debating Society, Faculty of Law organized its 2nd National Online Judgment Writing Competition, 2023 which was held on 25th of March 2023. The competition was entirely in online mode. The competition was for all the Undergraduate and Postgraduate students pursuing law. The organizers received over 60+ entries from top institutions all over India and the response was overwhelming.

The Judgement Preposition was released at 10:00 am on the 25th of March 2023 and the submission time was on the same day. The entries reeled in on time with tremendous efforts from the authors and their co-authors. The entries were checked on the criteria of plagiarism, knowledge of statutes, persuasiveness, drafting skills, etc. by the panel of experts which consists of faculty members from the Faculty of Law.
