The 3rd Intra Debate Competition, organized by the Moot Court and Debating Society, Faculty of Law, Integral University took place on the 25th and 26th of September, 2023, at the Faculty of Law, Integral University. The topic of the Intra-Debate was "Artificial Intelligence in Education System: A Boon or A Bane". The event brought together talented debaters from our institution to engage in intellectual discourse and showcase their debating skills. On the 25 th of September, 2023 Preliminary Round (Screening) was conducted, the judges for the Screening round were:
