A Brief Report on "Road Safety Awareness Program" on State Highway-77C held on 10th October 2024 organized by the Department of Civil Engineering, Integral University Lucknow

The Department of Civil Engineering at Integral University, under the aegis of the office of Dean Student Welfare, organized a road safety awareness program at Gate 2, State Highway-77C on 10th October 2024, as part of the "Sadak Suraksha Pakhwada" initiative being celebrated across Uttar Pradesh from 2nd October to 16th October 2024. The program, coordinated by Mr. Mohd Sadat and Mr. Mohd Sajid, with assistance from Mr. Mohd Riyaz and Mr. Rajat Verma, saw active participation from sixty-three students and twenty road users. The event focused on educating participants about essential road safety measures such as wearing helmets and seatbelts, avoiding mobile phone usage while driving, adhering to speed limits, and following traffic signals. The students of B.Tech Civil Engineering played a key role in the event, contributing to the program's success in promoting safe driving practices and aligning with the objectives of the "Sadak Suraksha Pakhwada" campaign.





A camp was organized at SH-77C to raise awareness among road users about the importance of following safety precautions while driving. Many drivers were found engaging in risky behaviors, such as using mobile phones while driving, not wearing seatbelts, riding two-wheelers without helmets, driving on the wrong side of the road, and failing to obey traffic signals. Some drivers made turns without giving proper signals, while others were involved in rash driving and exceeded speed limits. There were also instances of three people riding on a single two-wheeler.





During the camp, road users were educated on the dangers of these actions and how they can lead to serious accidents. They were also informed about the fines imposed by authorities for traffic violations, with special emphasis on the importance of obeying traffic signals. The session highlighted the online challan system for signal violations. Additionally, pedestrians were made aware of the importance of using zebra crossings and the time allocated for safe crossing at signalized intersections.
