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Brief Report on

“3D-PAINTING WORKSHOP”
held on **10th October, 2024****Organized by****Department of Architecture, Integral University, Lucknow**

The Faculty of Architecture, Planning & Design organized a hands-on **3D-Painting Workshop** for students on **10th October, 2024**. The workshop was conducted by the renowned artist **Mrs. Rashmi Shukla**, a distinguished alumna of the **Lalit Kala Academy, Lucknow**, with a B.F.A. and M.F.A. in painting. Mrs. Shukla brought her wealth of expertise in 3D painting, an art form that explores the illusion of depth and perspective on flat surfaces.

The workshop aimed to introduce participants to the fundamentals of creating realistic 3D artwork using vibrant acrylic paints, while enhancing their creative skills in manipulating textures and color combinations. The participants gained insights into the intricate techniques required for creating visual illusions on canvas, focusing on depth, perspective, and shading to make their paintings come alive.

Workshop Highlights:

- **Interactive Session:** Mrs. Shukla engaged students with a step-by-step approach to painting, starting from basic strokes and gradually advancing to more complex techniques involving texture and perspective.
- **Hands-On Practice:** Participants used **A3 canvases** as their creative base and employed different brush sizes (0, 1, 3, 5, flat) to experiment with various painting styles.
- **Material Exploration:** Students experimented with **acrylic colours**, blending vibrant palettes to create depth, and worked with **textural supplies** such as moulded clay, water containers, and newspapers to manipulate surfaces.

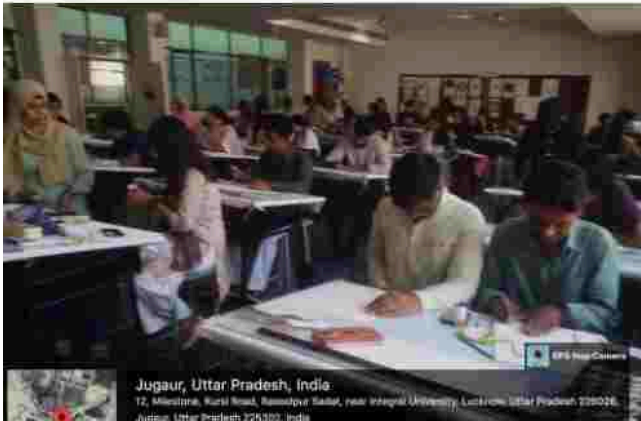
The event was meticulously organized, offering an enriching learning experience for students of the Faculty of Architecture, Planning & Design (FoAPD). The interactive nature of the workshop allowed students to explore their creativity, while learning to apply the skills of 3D painting in future projects. There were 57 participants overall. Students from various programs running under the Faculty of Architecture, Planning and Design (FoAPD) participated with great enthusiasm and promised to impart this knowledge in their regular work and studios as well.
