- Painting must be two-dimensional and can be created using any medium [e.g., acrylics, watercolors, oils, pastels, pencils, digital].
- The maximum size of the painting canvas should be A3 [No painting on any other material will be accepted].
- •Certificates of recognition will be awarded to the top three winning paintings
- Selected paintings may be featured in university publications and exhibited on campus.
- By entering the competition, participants grant the university non-exclusive rights to reproduce and display their painting for promotional and educational purposes, with appropriate attribution.
- The organizers reserve the right to disqualify any entry that does not adhere to these rules or that contains inappropriate content.
