<u>REPORT</u> GIRLS' BADMINTON TOURNAMENT Organised by ACTIVE MIND SPORTS CLUB

The Active Mind Sports Club of the Department of Computer Science and Engineering at Integral University, Lucknow, organized a Girls' Badminton Tournament on 23rd September 2024, 12:20 p.m. onwards, at the Badminton Court in Academic Block B. The tournament was aimed at encouraging female participation in sports and fostering healthy competition among students. A total of 12 participants took part in the event, representing different groups of the Computer Science and Engineering Department.

The tournament followed a knockout format. In the first round, 12 players competed, and from there, 6 players advanced to the quarterfinals. Additionally, 2 participants were selected for the quarterfinals based on their performance, as they lost by a small margin, making it a total of 8 participants in the quarterfinals. The intensity of the matches increased as 4 players reached the semifinals, and finally, the tournament culminated in a thrilling final match between Alishva and Noor Saniya. Alishva, a 2nd-year student from Group CSE-A, demonstrated exceptional skills throughout the tournament and emerged as the champion, defeating Noor Saniya, a fellow 2nd-year student from Group CSE-F, who finished as the runner-up.
