Thesis project titled **Adaptive Reuse of Musa Bagh, Lucknow** which was guided by Prof. Ar. Zeba Nisar.

As one of the winning entries of the Commendation Award, Ms. Sadia Ahmed's Thesis entry will be given the opportunity to publish her study in INTACH Journal of Heritage Studies, a bi-annual journal published by Indian National Trust for Art and Cultural Heritage, along with winning a cash prize of Rs. 15000, a book and a certificate.
