Workshop Report

One-Day Workshop on Laboratory Biosafety Training

The ICEIR and Department of Biosciences, Integral University, Lucknow, successfully conducted a One-Day Workshop on Laboratory Biosafety Training on December 7, 2024. The workshop aimed to enhance awareness and understanding of biosafety principles, containment practices, and risk assessment procedures among participants working in laboratory environments.

The workshop saw the enthusiastic participation of 40 attendees, which included research scholars, students, laboratory technicians, and faculty members.

Workshop Highlights:

The program began with **registration** at 8:30 AM, followed by a welcome address delivered by **Prof. Snober S. Mir**, Workshop Convener and Head of the Department of Biosciences.

Dr. B.N. Singh (Chief Scientist, CSIR-CDRI Lucknow and DBT NOMINEE, IBSC), the invited expert, delivered an engaging talk on "Biosafety Levels and Containment Practices" at 10:30 AM. His session provided critical insights into the principles of biosafety, various biosafety levels (BSL-1 to BSL-4), and safe laboratory practices. The session was highly interactive, with participants raising pertinent questions and receiving valuable guidance.

The afternoon session included **hands-on demonstrations** in the laboratories led by Dr. Kauser Mahmood Ansari (Principal Scientist, CSIR-IITR Lucknow) and other experienced faculty members. This practical training provided participants with real-world experience in biosafety risk assessments, proper handling of biological materials and waste management practices.

Workshop Objectives Achieved

- 1. Understanding the principles and significance of laboratory biosafety.
- 2. Gaining knowledge about biosafety levels (BSL) and containment measures.
- 3. Learning effective procedures for handling biological materials and ensuring safe laboratory practices.
- 4. Conducting biosafety risk assessments and complying with safety standards.
